Special Event: The Homer Ballard Challenge

This is a B,C,D,E shoot off based on the 12 gauge class of the shooter at the beginning of the shoot. Shoot off will be at stations 3, 4, and 5, miss and out by station. B class will shoot 410 Bore, C class will shoot 28 ga, D class will shoot 20 ga, and E class will shoot 12 gauge. A single prize of a belt buckle will be awarded.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is registered with the National Skeet Shooting Association and will be conducted in accordance with NSSA current rules and regulations

- All Referees will be NSSA Licensed, if possible. Their decisions are final.
- Classifications will be based on your NSSA card current classifications. Classification cards (full page) should be presented at time of registration. **(BRING YOUR CLASSIFICATION CARDS)** If skeet management uses classifications from NSSA at shooters request, HCGC is not responsible for errors. Shooters have to the end of shooting on Sunday to present up-to-date classifications. After that, all scores will be final and skeet management will not accept any changes to classifications for the shoot.
- Management reserves the right to refuse, change, eliminate, or postpone any part of the program.
- Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the harmony of the shoot.
- Gun Championships, Class First and any other place that has a payout will be shot-off. All others will be decided by long runs from the front or back, whichever is longer. Shooters must furnish shells for shoot-offs.
- Management reserves the right to long run all ties in the event shoot-offs cannot be held due to events beyond our control.
- Reloaded shells are permitted.
- Shooters are limited to one prize per event.
- All pets must be on a leash during the shoot.
- No pets are allowed in the club house.
- Contestants and spectators assume all risks of accident.
- Shooters under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent or guardian or have signed parent consent form to shoot.

DIRECTIONS TO THE CLUB

From the intersection of Philpott Rd (RT 58) and Main St (Rt 501) in South Boston, take Philpott Rd (RT 58) West. Go approximately 7 miles. The club is located on the right side of the road at 6200 Philpott Rd (RT 58).

From Danville, take South Boston Hwy/Philpot Rd. (Rt 360 and Rt 58) East approximately 28 miles. The club is located on the left side of the road at 6200 Philpott Rd. (Rt 58)
